

2023 Saddle Club Points System

Points system will run from January 1st to October 1st

This is an event geared towards the kids becoming more involved in the Saddle Club!

Rules for the points system

1. All club members are eligible to participate in the points system
2. Points will be given according to the following list
3. Members will be able to accumulate points based on the events that they participate in during the 4-H year.
4. Extra points can be achieved by helping with meeting set ups and tear down, during shows or clinics, and during fair week with events that happen during the week.
5. Members will be able to see their points at any time, but the rest of the club members points will not be shared with them
6. Members must stay for the entire event to get the points for being at the event. (Leader in charge of events has final say on points awarded.)
7. Parents cannot do the event for the 4-H member, the 4-H member has to be present to receive the points.
