



# Horse Camp Information!!!!

## Sunday June 16th Arrival

- 4:30-5:00 You may arrive during this time to set up your campers bunk area. Girls are in the home and family arts building and boys will be in the barn. We will have stalls marked that are available to them to set up their areas. Highly recommend cots or air mattress for either building as it is concrete floors. Plan to bring electric strips/extension cords if you have electronics you want to plug in as the outlets are limited.
- 5:00-6:00 Please check in at the showbooth to pick up your t-shirt, name tag, and pay any fees due. Please tack your horse and enter the main arena. You will line up here and be asked to mount and ride your horse for your group assignment. Please wait for us to give direction that we are ready for you before entering the arena. You will be given your color group and at that time you can make your way to the barn. We stall the horses together by group, this makes it easier on camp staff to know where everyone is. We are not able to give you your stall assignment without your group assignment.
- 6:00-7:00 We will do a brief parent meeting. During this time you are free to ask questions about camp as well as meet your child's leaders. Please let them know if there is anything that would help your child or horse have a better experience at camp. Barn tour with leaders-- introduction to safety in the barn and expectations. Parents tie a safety knot! We need to know that you know how to secure your animal. Parent dismissal.

## Wednesday June 19th

- 12:30-3:00 Campers will put on a show! Please come out if you can to watch and see what they have learned at camp! No horses will be pulled from the barn during this time as we are limited staff and need to be focused on the kids showing! We will have the dorm areas packed in the morning so you are welcome to stop in the dorm area to pick up items.
- 3:00-4:00 Award Ceremony-- Camp recap
- 4:00 Stall clean out/ check out-- each camper must have their stall card signed by a leader to verify that it is cleaned to Saddle Club standards (this will happen at fair as well). You will then take that card to the office or leader checking campers out. Please do not leave without doing this.
